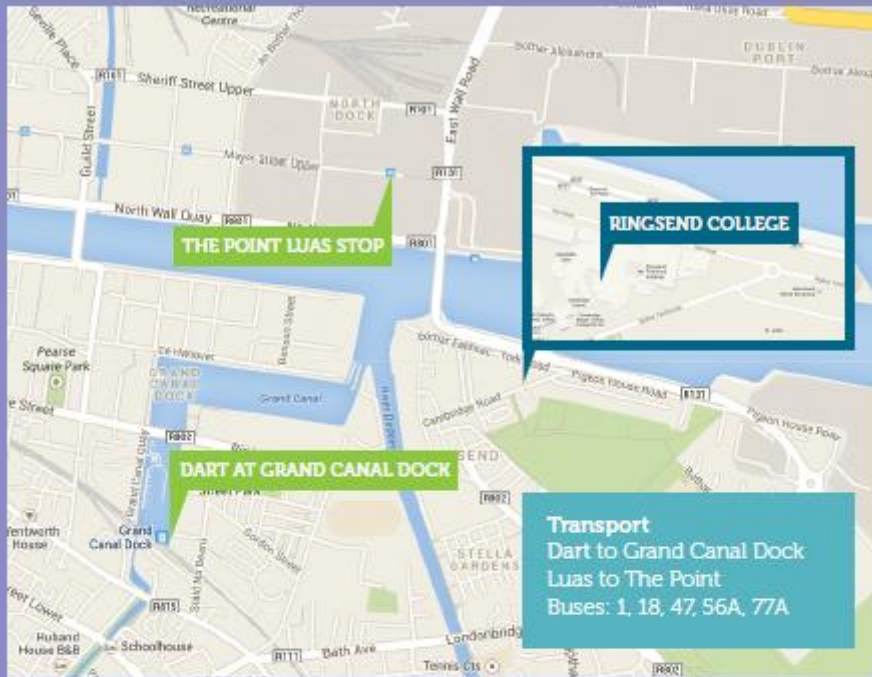

- in receipt of social welfare benefits
